- 1. This is the first subcommittee meeting.
- 2. The meeting was called to order at 1:30 pm.
- 3. The School Board cannot specify quotas for bidding based on race but can encourage minority contractor participation.
- 4. Ideas for promoting minority contractor participation in future WGSD bidding projects:
 - a. The School District typically advertises project bidding in the Webster-Kirkwood Times and St. Louis American.
 - b. Sponsor future project publicity fairs to introduce the upcoming project and promote relationships with minority firms.
 - District currently hosts town hall meetings early in project design to show renderings and inform the public.
 - We can ask prime General Contractors (GC) bidding on WGSD projects how they are promoting minority contractor participation.
 - d. Consider developing bid procedures for future WGSD construction projects and establishing goals for minority subcontractor participation.
 - i. Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) and Requests for Proposal (RFP) should identify participation goals.
 - ii. Require minority subcontractors to provide proof of minority status and certify contract.
- 5. Next Steps for the subcommittee members:
 - a. Gather more information on this topic and other State of Missouri, municipalities, and school districts with minority participation policies.
 - b. Reach out to other General Contractors to get a cross-section of different processes.
 - c. Schedule a meeting for next month.
