



Read, Right, & Run is a once per month after school activity for kindergarten through 5th grade. The program's goal is to challenge children by inspiring them to READ 26 books, RIGHT the community with 26 good deeds, and RUN 26.2 miles over a 26-week period. After 26 weeks of hard work, the program ends with a race at Forest Park and the kids complete their 1.2mile or 5K run!

Each month, the READ, RIGHT, & RUN group will meet after school from 2:50-4:15pm at Clark. The group will stretch, run, enjoy a snack, complete a good deed, and read a story aloud.

Last year we had 80 Clark students participating in R, R, & R. If we have the same turnout as last year, Coach Tilford will split the group between two different days.
