

GREEN TEAM EXPECTATIONS & PROCEDURES

READY- Come to class with all necessary materials.

RESPECTFUL- Come to class on time.

Be respectful of those with different opinions and open to new ideas.
It is okay to agree to disagree, and then move on.

RESPONSIBLE - Be responsible for your own learning.

Ask for help when needed and advocate for yourself.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:

- Each Green Team Teacher will ensure that all students understand the classroom structures and routines required for a safe learning environment in his/her classroom
- Behavioral expectations and agreements will be developed collaboratively with students
- Classroom supplies needed on a daily basis for every class
 - For every class, please bring:
 - Writing Tool - pen or pencil
 - Composition Notebook for ELA & Science class
 - Independent Reading Book
 - Earbuds (though they should not be worn without teacher permission)
 - Folder
- Leaving the classroom
 - Students are expected to use passing period to visit their lockers for supplies and to take care of all biological needs
 - When it is necessary to leave the class, students will always communicate with the teacher before leaving
 - Students must sign out/sign in on clipboard by the door when they leave
 - Continuous requests to leave the classroom may result in loss of privileges

HALLWAY EXPECTATIONS

- Tardy - the Green Team adheres Hixson's tardy policy:
 - Student must be in classroom when the tardy bell rings.
 - If students continuously arrive to class unprepared, they will begin receiving tardies.
 - If students arrive to school after 8:35, they must get a pass from the office.
 - 1st tardy: warning
 - 2nd tardy: call home and warning about 3rd tardy

- 3rd tardy: detention with teacher
- 4th tardy and additional tardies beyond that: referral to the office and a consequence from administration

Tardies reset at semester.

- Lockers
 - Once students have their materials, they should make their way to class.
 - Students will leave backpacks in lockers, but they may bring cinch sacs to class.
 - Students will leave big coats in lockers.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Cell phones and ear buds should not be used in hallways during passing periods.

- Chromebooks
 - You will be assigned a Chromebook to use in each Green Team classroom.
 - You are responsible for returning the Chromebook to its proper location and plugging in the charger after each use.
 - Carry your computer with two hands. Do NOT grab or carry your Chromebook by the display. You will be responsible for any damage caused to a Chromebook.
 - No gaming, shopping, youtube, music without permission in the classroom. Multiple issues may result in loss of Chromebook privileges.
- Phones
 - Should be silent and out of sight unless a teacher requests usage.
 - Earbuds should not be in your ears unless your teacher gives you permission.
 - Phone Policy - if you text, game, shop, watch Youtube, Snapchat, use any social media, take pictures, or use your phone for any other non-academic endeavor or app, your phone will be taken.
 - 1st offense: Cell phone is taken and sent to the office.
 - 2nd offense: Cell phone is taken and sent to the office.
 - 3rd offense: Your parent must come to school to retrieve your phone.
