# How Does A Laborer's Apprenticeship Begin?

#### Requirements

- Must be 18 Years of Age
- Must have a High School Diploma or a GED

#### Begin a Career as a Laborer

- Visit LiUNABuildsMO.com
  - Online tool allows you to introduce yourself to the LiUNA locals
  - No guarantee of employment / Provides an excellent means of introduction
  - Follow up will come from the Training School or the Local Hall

## Selection - Letter of Intent Program

- The Apprenticeship Program shall be a "Letter of Intent" type program
- Interested persons may enter the Program provided they have an employer willing to sponsor them for the term of Apprenticeship and under the guidelines of the Program
- When an applicant locates an employer willing to hire an apprentice, the employer will provide the applicant with a written offer of employment (Letter of Intent)
- Applicant must agree to a physical examination and alcohol and drug screening as a condition of employment



## Laborer's Apprenticeship to Journey Level Status

#### Earn While you Learn

- On the Job Training (4000 hours) / Skills Classes at our Training Center (300 378 hours)
- Construction Craft Laborers usually finish their apprenticeship in 32 38 months.
- Same pension, health and welfare benefits as Journey level Laborers
- Training provided at NO COST

#### Aging Infrastructure Must Be Addresses

- American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) evaluates every 4 years and gave Missouri a grade of C- in 2021
- Missouri has the 7<sup>th</sup> Largest Highway system in the nation
- Missouri sewer systems are reaching 100 years of service designed for 50 years of service
- "Flash Floods are becoming Flashier"
- 900 Bridges in Missouri rated "Poor" by the Federal Highway Administration

## Aging Workforce Represents Future Opportunities

- 29% of current construction workforce will retire by 2026
- 41% of current construction workforce will retire by 2031








## Reference – Tasks Normally Performed by Laborer's

#### Laborer's...

- Check grade for highway construction and excavation and backfilling operations
- Place concrete and work with concrete forms
- Install sewer / water systems including fusing polyethylene pipe
- Perform demolition and building alterations using oxyacetylene and air plasma cutting equipment
- Operate rock drilling equipment and set charges for blasting operations
- Lay asphalt and place concrete pavements for highways, roads and parking lots
- Build scaffolding
- Use rigging and signaling skills to distribute building materials
- Operate skid steer loaders used in concrete construction and rough terrain forklifts used in masonry construction
- Operate and maintain an array of pneumatic, gas engine and electric power tools
- Use levels, transits, laser beam equipment and ground positioning systems (GPS) in excavation and grading operations
- Perform asbestos and lead abatement as well as hazardous waste operations
- Landscaping, planting, irrigation systems, hydroseeding, tree trimming and maintenance
- Perform subway rehabilitation, station repair, platform construction and track replacement
- Tunnel construction including boring and excavating for installation of track placement, roadway surfacing and water infrastructure
- Maintain general site conditions, clean up, debris removal, tending and working with all trades
- And many more tasks
