

After inspecting the theatre space at Webster Groves High School, ITC is declining to submit a bid to update the rigging and the softgoods. In order to perform work OSHA safety concerns would need to be addressed. Additionally during my inspection I discovered other safety concerns that should be addressed for the safety of the space. Please see below for photos and notes. This list is not a comprehensive list of issues a licensed mechanical contractor should be contracted to diagnose and address all issues in this space.




I was unable to inspect the head blocks or loft blocks for for the fly system because the ladder to the grid was not code compliant. It lacks a safety cage and was inadequately affixed to the building structure.



In the fly gallery there is insufficient space to work on the rigging.

Additionally handrail height does not meet OSHA requirements. There is no secure point for workers to tie off for fall protection.






Non rated hardware affixing track to building structure


Inappropriately revved drum wire rope is crossing itself


Inadequate clew block non rated wire rope clips inappropriately applied wire rope clips inadequate turnback


Track sections for FOH electric stacked and inappropriately attached.
