Mr. Allen is a 1942 graduate of Webster Groves High School, a survivor of the Battle of the Bulge and grandfather of Chris Allen, the varsity girls soccer coach. Mr. Allen loves WGHS and desires to support our current generation of Statesmen and Stateswomen.

The WGHS and the Alumni Department continue to work together to fund raise the money needed to build the press box. Once all funding is in hand, the district will provide more details and recommendations to the Board of Education regarding this project. The funds will <u>be deposited</u> in an activity account dedicated to this project.
