

The counseling program includes guidance curriculum for students in grades K-5. Counselors, teachers, and community experts may teach the curriculum which includes the following areas of study:

- KNOWLEDGE OF SELF AND OTHERS
- MAKING DECISIONS
- STUDY SKILLS
- GOAL SETTING
- KNOWING HOW DRUGS AND ALCOHOL AFFECT SELF AND OTHERS
- CAREER EXPLORATION

The curriculum is addressed through a variety of methods including songs, activity sheets, class discussions, role-playing, videos, art, assemblies, guest speakers, stories, and books. Students are encouraged to use “I statements” to express their feelings appropriately. Elementary counselors also serve as building coordinators for the MAP and other standardized tests. In addition, the counseling department offers brief individual counseling, student support groups and in collaboration with the school social worker, referrals to outside resources.

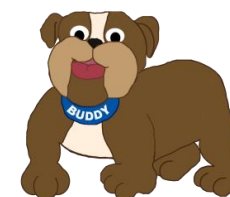
