

Sample of Enrollment Space Options

Enrollment Policies: This would include a variety of district policies and practices such as allowing students to transfer from one attendance zone to another, allowing non-resident staff's children to attend, tuition-paying students, etc.

Class Size Standards: Currently there are class size standards used which, at the elementary level, serve as a guide for adding or reducing sections at a grade level. Raising these standards to a certain level would have an impact on the number of classes needed in schools (as classes would possibly be larger).

Grade Level Configurations: Moving a grade level (s) from one building to another (or others).

Elementary Attendance Zones: Redrawing elementary "boundary lines" which determine the "home school" for each family.

Reconfiguration and/or Addition of Space: This could include reconfiguring/constructing new space within an existing school's "foot print" or constructing new space onto the school.

School Year Schedule: Redesign the school year schedule so that all district students aren't going to school at the exact same time.

School Choice Options: Create a school choice option and process that promotes enrollment relief within one or more schools.

Lease Space: Find off-campus space to lease for classroom use.
